Registration Instructions

This exam is a webcam proctored exam and is internet based with pre-recorded prompts. Your exam will be recorded for rating by American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Certified Raters. Test length is approximately 20-40 minutes but please allow at least 60 minutes to take the exam. You may schedule your exam at a date and time that is convenient to your schedule. Your test results will be available in 1-5 days.

To register for your online assessment, please follow the following directions:

- Go to <u>www.languagetesting.com</u> to purchase your test and set up your account.
- On the upper right had corner, select "Search for your institution or school program"
- Answer "no" to the question about testing for teacher certification.
- In the blank under "Enter your institution" enter "**UNLV-Individual**." When you start typing you will see it pop up and you can select it and click CONTINUE.
- Select your LANGUAGE from the drop down menu. Continue.
- On the next page, select your test choose "Select Test" so that you see it populate in your cart, and click CONTINUE.



• Answer the self-assessment questionnaire—be sure to choose the correct level as indicated by the orange arrows, so that you can be tested at the Advanced-Mid level rating. Do not choose the lower three options— or you will not be able to qualify regardless of your score.
